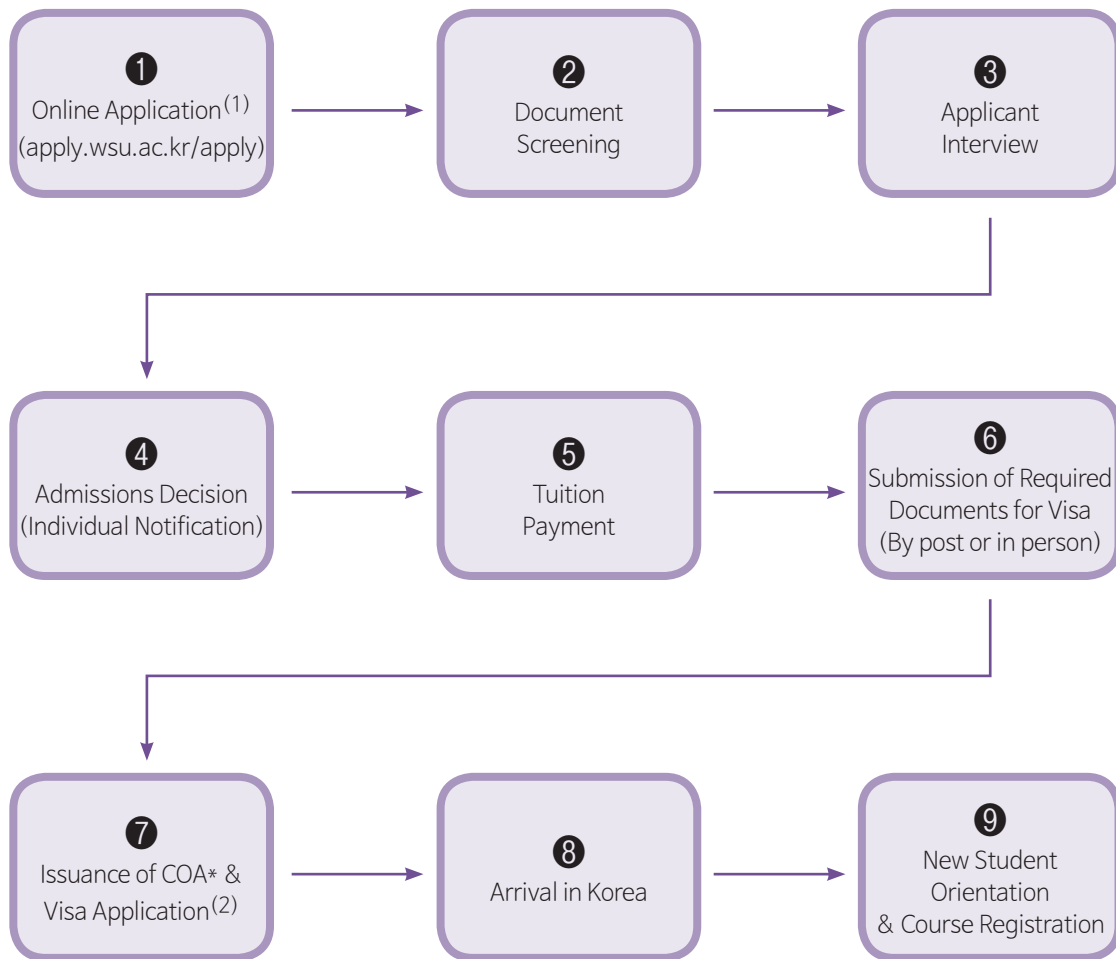

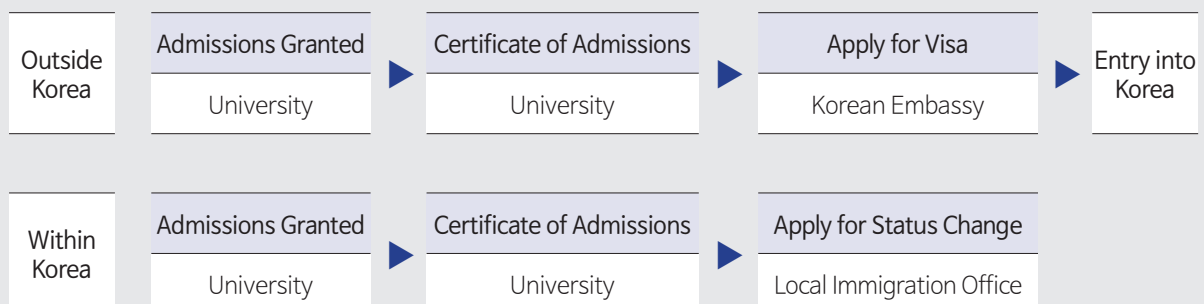

Application Submission	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▶ Applicants may apply to only one academic unit. If applications are submitted to more than one unit, all applications will be void.</li> <li>▶ Once the application has been submitted, it cannot be cancelled, and changes to the chosen department or any submitted information are not permitted.</li> <li>▶ Applicants must provide accurate contact information (phone number, mailing address, etc.) so that they can be reached during the admissions period. The applicant is solely responsible for any disadvantages resulting from errors, omissions, or incorrect entries.</li> </ul>
Required Documents	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▶ All documents must be submitted in their original form. For documents that cannot be reissued, a certified copy must be submitted, either verified against the original by the issuing institution (original verification stamp/seal) or notarized by an authorized notary office (in the case of China, through a public notary).</li> <li>▶ Any document not written in Korean or English must be accompanied by a notarized translation in Korean or English.</li> <li>▶ Submitted documents will not be returned under any circumstances. If any submitted document is found to be falsified or if admission was obtained through dishonest means (e.g., proxy attendance at an interview), the admissions offered or enrollment will be revoked.</li> <li>▶ If the facts cannot be verified solely from the documents submitted by the applicant, the University may request additional documents. Applications with insufficient document to verify the facts will be deemed ineligible.</li> <li>▶ Applicants who are expected to graduate or complete their program (i.e., currently enrolled at the time of application) must submit their graduation or completion certificate to the Woosong University Office of International Affairs by August 14, 2026 (Fri). Failure to submit the required document by the specified date may result in cancellation of admission.</li> </ul>
